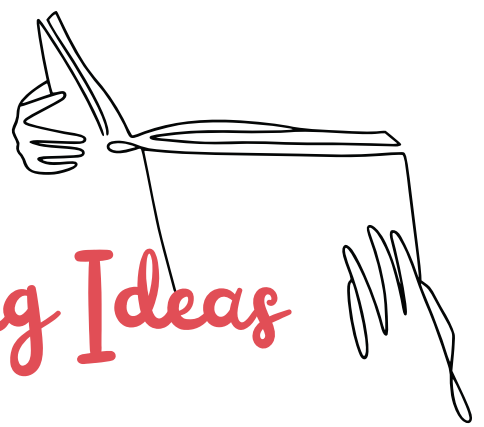
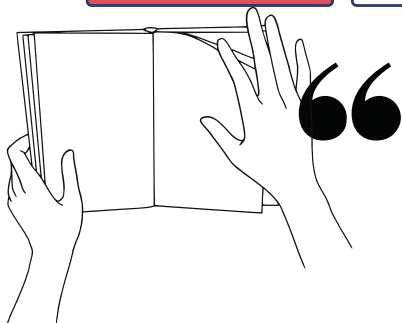


30 Holiday Reading Ideas
